

DELANCO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 2010-8
AMENDING CHAPTER 295-40
GOVERNING “STOP INTERSECTIONS”

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco (“Township”), with input and advise from the Chief of Police, has determined that additional stop signs need to be added to existing intersections in order to protect the health safety and welfare of the Township residents, pedestrians and traveling public; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 295-40 of the Township Code governs “Stop Intersections.”

NOW , THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 295-40 is hereby amended to add the following intersections:

Section 1. [added intersections]

Stop Sign on	At Intersection of
Second Street	Union Avenue
Second Street	Edgewood Avenue
Second Street	Lilac Lane

Section 2. Repealer. Any Ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of its inconsistency.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is deemed unlawful by a Court is found to be contrary to law by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be of no force or effect; but the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.

The above entitled ordinance was passed on first reading at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco on April 19, 2010. It will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing at the regularly scheduled meeting to be held on May 17, 2010 at the Municipal Building, 770 Coopertown Road, Delanco, NJ at 7:30PM at which time and place any persons desiring to be heard upon the same will be given the opportunity to be heard. Copies of this ordinance will be made available at the Municipal Clerk’s office to members of the general public who shall request them.
