**Alkaline Batteries
DO NOT RECYCLE**

ALKALINE BATTERIES come in AAA, AA, C, D, and 9 Volt sizes. They do not contain mercury.

Put them in your household trash.

The two main types of household batteries are *alkaline* and *rechargeable*.



**Rechargeable Batteries
RECYCLE AT

STORES**

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES come in the same sizes as alkaline batteries, but also include batteries used for laptops, portable tools and toys. Rechargeable batteries include Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) and Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb) batteries.
