
Never Put Batteries in Recycling!

BATTERIES ARE CAUSING FIRES AT OUR RECYCLING CENTER!



ALKALINE BATTERIES come in AAA, AA, C, D, and 9 Volt sizes. They do not contain mercury.

Put them in your household trash.

The two main types of household batteries are alkaline and rechargeable.



RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES come in the same sizes as alkaline batteries, but also include batteries used for laptops, portable tools and toys. Rechargeable batteries include Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) and Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb) batteries.
