ORDINANCE 2019-21

AMENDING CHAPTER 10-6 GOVERNING "POLICE" PROVIDING FOR OUTSOURCING ARRANGEMENTS TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES TO PRIVATE OR PUBLIC ENTITIES

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Administrator have recommended that the Police Department could be better managed by permitting the contracting out for services to arrange for Officers to provide traffic and/or security services to private or public entities; and

WHEREAS, the current provision in the Township Code details the process, including fees and costs, but is not clear on the use of a contracted service for making these arrangements and charging an additional fee to private or public entities who request use of this service; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee agrees with the recommendation and desires to amend the Township Code to provide for this optional contracted service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 10-6, governing "Police" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 10-6. Police.

Section N. Outside employment through the Police Department:

(3) Contracts with private emloyers or public entities.

Shall be amended to add the following:

(d) The Township holds the right to outsource, by contract, the police department Outside Employment process to a third party vendor to administer. The vendor shall have the right to charge an additional fee, other than the officer, administration and any other fees set forth in this chapter. The vendor may handle scheduling, billing, collections, pay or other services previously performed by the Township.

<u>Section 2.</u> Repealer. Any Ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of its inconsistency.

<u>Section 3</u>. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is deemed unlawful by a Court is found to be contrary to law by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be of no force or effect; but the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
