**TOWNSHIP OF DELANCO**

**ORDINANCE 2011-10**

**AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE  
AT CHAPTER 250 GOVERNING “SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL”  
TO PROHIBIT THROWING OF SNOW OR ICE INTO PUBLIC STREETS**

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department of the Township of Delanco has advised the Township Committee that there have been numerous instances of cleared streets and sidewalks being re-covered in snow or ice due to snow throwing or otherwise casting of snow back into the streets or sidewalks in residents’ or businesses’ own efforts to clear their properties; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interests of the health, safety and welfare of the public, the Township desires to amend the Code to prohibit such activity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Township of Delanco be amended as follows:

**SECTION ONE.**

Chapter 250, governing “Snow and Ice Removal” is hereby amended to add the following subsection:

**§250-1.1.**

No person, corporation or entity shall plow, throw, place or otherwise deposit any snow or ice removed from any parking area, driveway, sidewalk or any other location into or upon any street, sidewalk, or other public thoroughfare or right-of-way within the Township.

**SECTION TWO:** All Ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION THREE:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION FOUR:** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
