**DELANCO TOWNSHIP**  
**ORDINANCE 2011-26**  
**AMENDING CHAPTER 295-40**  
**GOVERNING “STOP INTERSECTIONS”**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco (“Township”), with input and advice from the Chief of Police, has determined that an additional stop sign needs to be added to an existing intersection in order to protect the health safety and welfare of the Township residents, pedestrians and traveling public; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 295-40 of the Township Code governs “Stop Intersections.”

NOW , THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 295-40 is hereby amended to add the following intersection:

Section 1. [added intersections]

**Stop Sign on**

Vine Street

**At Intersection of**

Ash Street

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 and 39:4-8, additional stop sign locations may be added or removed by Resolution, and a list may be kept on file by the Township Clerk or the Chief of Police.

Section 2. Repealer. Any Ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of its inconsistency.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is deemed unlawful by a Court is found to be contrary to law by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be of no force or effect; but the remainder of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
