DELANCO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE 2006-22

An ordinance amending Chapter 218 governing “Peace and Good Order”

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco (“Township”) is dedicated to improving and preserving the appearance of the Township for the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township has reviewed existing Code provisions, with regard to peace and good order in an effort to improve existing regulations and allow for better enforcement of existing provisions.

NOW, WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delanco as follows:

Section 1:

Chapter 218 governing “Peace and Good Order” is hereby amended as follows: Chapter 218-1.A is hereby amended as follows to add new subsection (32) as follows:

(32) Depositing substances in streets. No person shall place or throw or suffer or permit the depositing of any stone, sticks, glass, snow or ice or any hard, dangerous or offensive substance upon any street, avenue, road, highway or other public thoroughfare, nor shall any person throw any such object or substance at, upon or against any person, vehicle of transportation, building or other structure.

Section 2: Repealer, Severability and Effective Date.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Committee hereby declares it intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage and approval in accordance with the law.
