Christmas Tree & Brush Collection will take place the second week of January. Trees must be placed curbside, but not on the paved surface of the right-of-way, nor the abutting sidewalk, if one exists. Please do not put trees out after this time. Please Note: Do not put trees out in bags and remember to remove all lights and ornaments! Artificial Christmas Trees can go out with the regular scheduled trash collection.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

❖ IN THE EVENT OF SNOW: Please do not park your car in the street for 48 hours after a snow fall so the Delanco Public Works can clear the streets from curb to curb eliminating the buildup of ice along the curbs. State Law requires that no snow is to be thrown into the street after the streets have been plowed.

The Township would like to remind all property owners that they are responsible for removing all snow and ice from the sidewalks in front of their property within 12 hours of a snowfall. This is required by ordinance and enforcement and penalties have been set in the ordinance. Most children in Delanco walk to school and dangerous sidewalks are a liability to you as the property owner. Please comply with this ordinance.

- ❖ State Law and Local Ordinance require that **ALL DOGS AND CATS MUST BE LICENSED** in January. 2024 Licenses are available at the Township Clerk's Office in the Municipal Building, beginning Tuesday, January 2nd, 2024. Reminders will be mailed out at the end of December.
