> TRASH DISPOSAL OF MATTRESSES

We have been informed by our solid waste collection provider, Seaside Waste, that effective immediately, all mattresses must be fully wrapped in plastic/tarp material and secured with tape or secured inside a mattress disposal bag. Unwrapped mattresses or those that are not fully secure will not be collected.

- It has been noticed throughout town that there has been a large amount of clean out /construction debris going out for curbside pickup. Any remodeling or projects with excessive amounts of debris are not to be put out with regular trash and will need to get a dumpster. Curbside pickup is for regular household trash only. Please contact Delanco Township at 856-461-0561 for information on regulations for a dumpster.
- ➤ **RECYCLING CART PLACEMENT**, where you place your cart for collection is just as important as what goes in! <u>Click here</u> for details.
- > **SWIMMING POOLS**—Permits are required for Swimming Pools which can hold water 24 inches or more in depth. (Township Code, Chapter 254) This includes in ground, aboveground and on-ground swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, regardless if they are permanent structures or will be take down at the end of the summer.
- ➤ **GRASS CLIPPINGS** and/or other debris may not be blown into the street as it is a violation of our storm water plan and ordinance 2006-04. This type of debris can be washed by rain into the storm drains, then directly to our water supplies. Grass may be bagged and put out with your regular trash. *Let's work together to keep Delanco a Clean Community!*
