DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

1. Building Demolition Bid Documents

"Total Fixed Fee" - \$ 2,200.00

Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) proposes to provide the bid documents required to facilitate the demolition of the structure and conversion of the property to an open space.
