# LIBRARY SERVICES UPDATE

Beginning August 30th, as at other Burlington County Library locations, masks will be required within our library. Our facility is attached to an elementary school. We need to do all we can to support those who are heading back to school.

The situation is fluid and we will continue to abide by safety guidelines. The number of people in the library at one time will be monitored, computers are limited to 30 minute sessions and patrons are asked to limit their time in the library to approximately 30 - 45 minutes.

Socially distanced lobby pick up and parking lot pick up will continue as requested.
