IS A VOTE-BY-MAIL ELECTION UNDER
NJ STATE EXECUTIVE ORDER 177***

***EVERY REGISTERED VOTER IN THE STATE OF NEW
JERSEY WILL RECEIVE A VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT**

**THERE ARE FOUR WAYS TO RETURN YOUR COMPLETED VOTE BY MAIL
BALLOT:**

- 1. VIA U.S. MAIL (Must be post-marked by Nov. 3, 2020) OR**
- 2. PLACE COMPLETED BALLOT IN ONE OF THE SECURE DROP BOX
LOCATIONS IN BURLINGTON COUNTY.**

**Completed ballot must be in Drop Box by 8:00PM on Election Day,
November 3, 2020.**

- 3. RETURN COMPLETED BALLOT TO THE BURLINGTON
COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS OFFICE – 50 RANCOCAS
AVE., MOUNT HOLLY, NJ. OR**
- 4. RETURN COMPLETED BALLOT TO POLLING PLACE
(M. JOAN PEARSON SCHOOL, 1301 BURLINGTON AVE.,
DELANCO, NJ) ON ELECTION DAY ONLY BETWEEN 6:00am and
8:00pm. All districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6**

**REMEMBER: The November 3, 2020 General Election is a Vote-By-Mail
Election. Only qualifying disabled persons will be permitted to vote on the
electronic voting machine on Election Day. If you are not disabled, and wish
to vote in person on November 3rd, 2020 rather than use your VOTE-BY-MAIL
BALLOT, you will be required to fill out a paper provisional ballot at the polling
place on Election Day.**
