THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- READY TO START CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS? Permits are required for many types of construction jobs. Work must not be started until a permit is issued a permit number. Regular trash is not for construction materials. For more information on Construction/Inspections days and times, visit the Construction page under the Departments tab at <u>www.delancotownship.com</u>.
- SWIMMING POOLS—Permits are required for Swimming Pools which can hold water 24 inches or more in depth. (Township Code, Chapter 254) This includes inground, aboveground and on-ground swimming pools, hot tubs and spas, regardless if they are permanent structures or will be take down at the end of the summer.
- PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET! Delanco Code § 249-7-8 Requirement for disposal: All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person. Note, any owner or keeper who requires the use of a disability assistance animal shall be exempt from the provisions of this article while such animal is being used for that purpose.
