## FEMA/FIRM Flood Hazard Maps

Updated May 2018

Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), valid December 21, 2017, are now in effect for Delanco Township. There are six (6) FIRMs that include the Township:

Area of Delanco Township shown on this map panel
A small corner of the adjacent map north; old gypsum plant pier.
Northeast area: West Avenue Nature Trails Park & Phile Field.
Hawk Island western section.
Includes most of Delanco Township.
East side; Bogg's Run, Delanco Gardens, FOD & Pennington Parks
Far south corner of Township at Rt. 130 bridge.

The primary access to digital mapping information is online through the FEMA websites listed below. The Township does maintain a single paper copy of all Delanco FIRM maps. The Township also has a single copy of the Flood Information Study (FIS) report in six volumes. The FIS reports contain detailed flood survey data for Burlington County; all are accessible for download through the FEMA Map Service Center, website link below.

Websites to learn about the new flood hazard maps, protect your home, business, and property from floods.

- Make a printable flood hazard map ("FIRMette") of a specific location.

Type your address or location in search box. Map & aerial view of location will come up. Use +/- buttons to zoom in / out; verify the red cursor is on the address / location you desire. Click to move cursor to desired location. To make "FIRMette" map of this location to save, download, or print, click on "Dynamic Map" (this will take several seconds to produce). To download the full size flood map panel for this location, click "Map Image" (This will download the entire FIRM map panel – usually a large file, e.g., 12-18mb).
