- A Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) is an official flood map used in the National Flood Insurance Program.
- A FIRMette is a full-scale section of a FIRM that you create yourself.





<u>Step One</u> Find Your Flood Map

<u>Search by Address</u> is for finding all of the maps for your community. While <u>Search All</u> <u>Products</u> is useful for finding multiple FIRMs.



To create a FIRMette of the current Effective FIRM, select "View Map" This will take you to the *FIRMette* Web tool for your selected FIRM.



The buttons below let you view and print the selected flood map, download the flood map image, open an interactive flood map (if available), or expand the search to all products to view effective, preliminary, pending, or historic maps, and risk products for the community. The locator map shows flood map boundaries in your area of interest. You can choose a new flood map by clicking elsewhere on the locator map or entering a new location in the search box.

Once you've entered your community and selected "All Products", it will take you to a listing of all available products (including Historic FIRMs), for your selected jurisdiction that you can then choose to view in the FIRMette Web tool.

Please note: Searches often result in many map files listed under a given section. You can determine the Product ID for the individual map panel needed by looking at the Map Index file. The index map files have "IND" within the Product ID and appear at the start of the list. These index files show an overview of a jurisdiction and how it is subdivided into map panels with the Product ID for each panel shown.



<u>Step Two</u> Making FIRMettes in *FIRMette Web*


A new window will appear, containing the *FIRMette Web* tool, which will display the selected FIRM panel.

Select the "Make a FIRMette" button.






Making FIRMettes in FIRMette Web

- You may use the Zoom and Pan functions to more precisely identify the area you want in your FIRMette.
- However, you must be zoomed out all the way in order to make a FIRMette correctly.

When ready, click on your preferred output format, "Adobe PDF" or "Image File"






Making FIRMettes in FIRMette Web


 You can also go back and make additional **FIRMettes from** the same panel.





Making FIRMettes in FIRMette Web

Once you have saved and/or opened your FIRMette in your local viewer, you can print it out the on the appropriatesized paper corresponding to your earlier selection. To preserve the scale from the original FIRM map, save as PDF and change print settings to "actual size"






